Depending on supply, a flu nasal mist or injection will be available at the vaccination clinics.

Note: Vaccinations at public health clinics from November 16 through November 24 will be restricted to priority groups including: **children and young adults aged 6 months to 24 years, pregnant women, healthcare workers, persons caring for children under 6 months of age, and adults aged 24-64 with underlying medical conditions.*
